

Veteran Organization Name: Redstone Arsenal (RSA) Chapter of the US Army Warrant Officer Association (USAWOA)

Scholarship Name and Description: 2010 RSA WOA Scholarship Program.

Purpose of Scholarship: The goal of the program is to make financial awards to the most deserving candidate without putting undue emphasis on any particular aspect of the eligibility and application process. Decisions are made by a committee and are based on the whole person concept.

Type of Scholarship and Amount: Academic Scholarship: \$1,000.

Eligibility Criteria: Applications will be accepted from:

1. The children [(natural and adopted), dependent stepchildren under the age of 21 years (seniors in high school or currently enrolled college freshmen), adult non-traditional students (a student aged 21 years and older who is currently enrolled as a college sophomore or above and spouses)] of members of the Active, Reserve, National Guard, Retired Military and DOD Civilians in the Tennessee Valley area. (Dependent or sponsor lives in the Tennessee Valley area.) All applicants must plan to attend, or continue their education, in an accredited American college/university, vocational technical institution (e.g., Drake Technical College) on a full time basis. The school must be a degree-granting institution.

Criteria for submission: Applications must be complete at the time of receipt. No "partial" applications will be accepted. The application packet must consist of:

1. Basic Application form (see website).
2. A typewritten essay describing the educational goals of the applicant, and any voluntary work being performed for the community (150 – 600 words).
3. Recommendation from high school counselor, instructor, or current faculty advisor if already attending college or trade school. Nontraditional students will need a recommendation from a current/former faculty advisor.
4. Official High School (and college if applicable) transcripts showing a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
5. National Test Scores (i.e., SAT, ACT, etc.).

Date of submission and award time period: All application packets must be received prior to April 16, 2010 in order to be considered. Award will be announced by June 9, 2010. Awardee(s) will be personally contacted.
